BOLLINGER 'La Grande Anneé' 2005 8.

Reims, Champagne, France [66% Pinot Noir; 34% Chardonnay] La Grande Année is the ultimate expression of the Bollinger house style; rich and full one of the world's great Champagnes. Still family owned, this is a champagne house of world renown. In exceptional years they produce La Grande Annee, their Prestige Cuvee. 75% of the fruit is from Grand Cru sites, the remaining 25% from the finest Premier Cru, first fermentation is in 100% old oak barrels, aged for 5 years on its lees.

Domaine Coteau de la Biche, Vouvray, Loire, France

From the oldest established estate in Vouvray (est 1739) this spectacular wine is a true reflection of how good Chenin Blanc can be when it is coupled with great 'terroir'. The palate is a glory of intense grapey, lime fresh fruit flavours, very dry with a hint of acaicia honey on the finish. Perfect with rich fish, and autumn squash and mushroom dishes.

25. SAUVIGNON BLANC 'LANARK LANE' 2016/17

Marlborough, New Zealand

Pale straw in colour with a bouquet of classic Marlborough characters - intense green nettle aromas of gooseberry, redcurrant and citrus. The palate is well-balanced and vibrant with persistent flavours and crisp acidity.

26. SAUVIGNON BLANC 2016

Casas del Bosque, Casablanca, Chile

Pure, vibrant and concentrated cool climate New World Sauvignon from talented Kiwi winemaker, Grant Phelps. On the nose intense notes of lime, grapefruit and fresh ginger with just a hint of salinity. In the mouth, bright tropical and citrus zest flavours give way to a tight mineral backbone and rapier-like acidity.

27. 'SANDBAR' BACCHUS, 2015 *HOMEGROWN- ENGLISH WINE*

Lyme Bay Winery, Axe Valley, Devon

This 100% Bacchus wine comes from grapes grown exclusively in the Lyme Bay Winery's Southcote Vineyard. It is off-dry, crisp and displays refreshing notes of grapefruit, nettle and elderflower, with an exceptionally long finish. Superb with fresh seafood.

29. VIOGNIER 2016

Domaine St. Hilaire, Pays d'Oc, France

Domaine St Hilaire's Viognier is alluringly exotic, with aromas of ripe apricots, peaches and honeysuckle. The palate exudes lush and unctuous fruit flavours, which is due to the fact that the vines are over twenty years old and were planted long before this variety became fashionable.

30. GEWÜRZTRAMINER 2016

Villa Wolf, Pfalz, Germany

Quite the best Gewurztraminer we have tasted outside Alsace. Crisp, fresh and utterly charming with delicate flavours of rose petal and lychee, hints of honeysuckle on the nose and a lingering, zesty finish.

31. RIESLING KABINETT 2015/16 - Halbtrocken

Koester Wolf, Rheinhessen, Germany

A mineral-scented, off-dry Riesling which shows flinty, lime aromas with a rounded yet refreshing palate. Claus and Barbel Wolf run this 33 acre estate in Germany's Rheinhessen region, which is the source of some of Germany's best-value white wine, and has been <u>at the</u> forefront of Germany's revolution in wine quality over the last decade.

32. RIOJA BLANCO 'Hacienda Lopez de Haro' 2016

Bodega Classica, Rioja Alta, Spain

A truly modern style of unoaked white Rioja, offering the best of both worlds: full, ripe apple and peach fruit overlaid with the clean, crisp texture for which the Viura grape is so well known. A truly versatile match for a wide variety of dishes.

33. PICPOUL DE PINET 2016

Domaine St. Peyre, Languedoc, France

Dry, crisp and fragrant, with a distinctive nutty nuance. Perfect with seafood, white fish, poultry or as an aperitif. The grape is Picpoul and the village is Pinet, about 10km north of Adge, near Marseille. It's what the locals drink with the famous oysters of the region and is little seen in this country.

34. CHATEAU THIVIN 'Cuvée Marguerite' 2015/16

Odenas, Beaujolais, France

Cuvée Marguerite is an unusual white Beaujolais-Villages made from 100% Chardonnay, grown on a seam of clay-chalk soil in the parish of St Lager. A lovely light, elegant colour, with an exceedingly fine nose of white flowers and citrus and a round and complex palate. This wine is outstanding!

36. PULIGNY MONTRACHET 'Les Charmes' 2015

Domaine Jean Louis Chavy, Burgundy, France From one of the finest estates in Puligny comes this almost perfect expression of white Burgundy from a superb vintage. Tremendous purity of fruit and a concentrated, rich, creamy finish.

37. CHARDONNAY 'Whistling Duck' 2017 [UNWOODED]
Calabria Family Wines, Griffith, New South Wales, Australia
A fresh, vibrant Chardonnay with aromas of tropical and citrus fruit. The palate is rounded and well-balanced with lemon zest and stone fruit flavours.

38. DART VALLEY RESERVE 2016 *HOMEGROWN- ENGLISH WINE*

Sharpham Vineyard, Totnes, Devon Everything we expect from Sharpham Vineyard - skilfully blending Madeleine Angevine and Pheonix grape varieties to produce an off-dry, light and fresh wine which works well with or without food.

39. CÔTES DU RHÔNE Blanc 'César' 2014/15 [ORGANIC & BIODYNAMIC]

Domaine Roche-Audran, Buisson, Southern Rhône, France A beautifully aromatic white with aromas of honeysuckle and acacia. Full-bodied on the palate with a perfect balance between fruit and acidity. Lovingly crafted by talented winemaker Vincent Rochette from Grenache Blanc and Viognier.

75. GRENACHE-MERLOT ROSÉ 'Les Terrasses' 2016

- Les Vignerons Ardéchois, Ardèche, France
- A crisp rosé from the Cevennes mountains, dry, but full of concentrated summer berry fruit.

42. FLEURIE 2015 32.00 Olivier Ravier, Beaujolais, France Fleurie is known as the 'Queen' of Beaujolais because of its elegance and finesse. Produced from 100% old vine Gamay, this is fresh, light and ultra-juicy.

43. PINOT NOIR 2017

Whale Point, South Eastern Australia

A pale ruby red Pinot with a soft nose of redcurrants and red cherries. The palate is very smooth with a core of red cherry and raspberry fruit and hints of sweet spices supported by supple tannins.

44. GAMAY 'Eclat de Granite' 2016

Robert Serol, Côtes Roannaise, Loire, France From a virtually unknown (in the UK anyway) region in the southern Loire, this is absolutely superb Old Vine Gamay with all the elegance and finesse of a top notch cru Beaujolais. A deliciously pure, fresh and aromatic red bursting with rich, ripe, velvety raspberry fruit, with an underlying earthy sweet complexity and an intensely long finish.

45. CÔTES DE NUITS VILLAGES 2014/15

Domaine Xavier Durand, Burgundy, France [100% Pinot Noir] The energetic and highly talented young Xavier Durand has propelled this domaine into the region's premier league. These are wines of great precision and freshness, with a wonderful purity. Xavier's reds from the Côte de Nuits surpass many a Nuits St. Georges and are phenomenal value.

46. GEVREY CHAMBERTIN 'En Champs' 2013

Domaine des Tilleuls, Côte de Nuits, Burgundy, France Supple and elegant with meaty, plush, dark berry and cherry fruit, hints of liquorice, excellent balancing acidity and some light earthy notes on the finish. This 8.5 hectare has undergone a total regeneration since 2007, with superb results.

47. CHÂTEAU DES JOUALLES 2010

Bordeaux Supérieur, France From the same team that made the excellent Château Lassegue St Emilion. This is deeply coloured, ripe, fruit-driven Claret with excellent structure.

48. RIOJA CRIANZA 'Hacienda Lopez de Haro' 2015

[60% Merlot; 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Cabernet Franc]

Bodega Classica, Rioja, Spain

A smooth and velvety Crianza that feels quite classical in style but puts on a very modern display of vibrant ripe fruit. A blend of old-vines Tempranillo, Garnacha and Graciano that sees 18 months in French and American oak, it shows clean, spicy dark fruit with hints of leather, coffee and dried herbs. The palate is polished and succulent with sweet, rounded tannins and well-integrated toasty vanilla oak. (Robert Parker - 91 points)

49. **PINOT NOIR 2015**

Paul Cluver, Elgin, South Africa This is one of the best, most "Burgundian" examples of Pinot we have tasted from the New World. Lots of wild berry fruit on the nose complemented with hints of chocolate, violet and coffee. The complex palate is brimming with lingering sweet berry flavours and the finish is long and velvety.

Villa Domiziano, Tuscany, Italy

Made from hand-harvested grapes from Chianti Classico vineyards this has the classic black cherry, raspberry and olive stone flavours of 'proper' Chianti. Velvety with great tannin structure.

52. APPASSIMENTO ROSSO 2015/16

Vino Passito, Puglia, Italy

A full bodied wine made from carefully selected grapes that are sun-dried on the vine. This method, called Appassimento, increases the concentration of fruit and flavours and produces a rich, complex and fruity wine with notes of ripe dark cherries, fresh herbs and vanilla.

53. **PINOTAGE 2016**

Slowine, Overberg, Western Cape, South Africa A deliciously juicy Pinotage full of summer plums and spice with a big, luscious mouthfeel and a peppery finish. 'Slowine' is a collective project by producers from the area around the Groenland Mountain who believe in the 'Slow living' ethos. Some of the proceeds from the sale of these wines is dedicated to the conservation of the Padloper tortoise who features on the wine label.

54. MERLOT- SYRAH 'Les Terrasses' 2016

Les Vignerons Ardéchois, Ardèche, France

A soft, rounded and fruity red from long-established vineyards in the foothills of the Cevennes mountains, between the Ardèche and La Baume rivers. Deep-coloured with a bouquet of red cherries, this is well -balanced and very approachable with an emphasis on ripeness and 'crunchy' fruit.

56. MONASTRELL 'La Tremenda' 2016

Enrique Mendoza, Alicante, Spain Intense, succulent bramble fruit with complex spicy nuances. Ripe, supple, complex and utterly beguiling.

57. MERLOT 2017

steadfastly traditional

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Cornellana Estate, Rapel Valley, Chile

Rich, deep and plummy with hints of chocolate on the nose. It is easy to see why Chile has become a spiritual home for Merlot.

58. CÔTES DU RHÔNE VILLAGES 'Visan' 2015 [ORGANIC & BIODYNAMIC]

Domaine Roche-Audran, Buisson, Rhône, France

A deep-coloured meaty red with excellent purity of fruit and a fleshiness combined with suppleness that is so rarely achieved. Wonderful complexity and a long finish. This is very talented wine-making indeed.

59. MASSAYA 'Le Colombier' 2015

Tanail Estate, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon

One of our most exciting discoveries, this is the result of a collaboration between one of the best Chateauneuf du Pape producers (Daniel Brunier of Vieux Telegraphe), Dominique Hebrard of Chateau Trianon (St Emilion) and the Lebanese proprietors of this estate, Sami and Ramzi Ghosn. A smooth, supple and spicy blend of Cinsault, Grenache, Tempranillo and Syrah, it's amazing and quite unique.

60. MALBEC 'ES Vino' 2017

Finca Sophenia, Tunpungato, Mendoza, Argentina

Intense aromas of cherries, blackberries, blueberries and fresh plums with spicy and floral notes. A complex, concentrated palate of ripe fruit with smooth tannins and a hint of chocolate on the finish. This modern winery is located in the high altitude Tupungato Valley region of Mendoza where the grapes benefit from a long, cool growing season and strong UV sunlight which helps maximise the aromas and complexity of the grapes. Superstar Bordeaux wine consultant Michel Rolland has added his expertise to this project.

61. SHIRAZ 'Whistling Duck' 2017

Calabria Family Wines, Griffith, New South Wales, Australia A sumptuous Aussie classic with rich flavours of ripe plums, dark cherries and fresh blackberries, and a dash of peppery spice on the finish.

62. PIC ST LOUP 'Dame Jeanne' 2015

Bergerie du Capucin, Languedoc, France

Relatively unkown here, but much appreciated in the rest of Europe, Pic St Loup is the Languedoc's hidden gem. A blend of Grenache, Syrah and Mourvedre, aged in oak for six months, this is lush and jam-packed with silky, spicy, gamey, blackberry and cherry fruit with a hint of liquorice and chocolate on the finish.

63. CABERNET SAUVIGNON 'BMW' 2011

Botham Merrill Willis, Coonawarra, Australia

Cricket legends and fellow wine buffs, Sir Ian Botham and Bob Willis joined forces with one of Australia's top wine makers, Geoff Merrill, to launch their own range of fine wines. The colour of this wine is very deep red with youthful purple hues. On the nose, intense varietal characters of menthol, black olive, mint and capsicum with subtle complex oak in the background. The palate is wonderfully supple and fleshy with fine, firm tannins providing excellent structure. Intense flavour, good length and well-balanced acidity complete this outstanding wine.

65. BAROLO RISERVA 2011

Costa di Bussia, Piedmont, Italy

Award-winning Barolo from a great producer. Matured in oak casks for three years to develop slightly gamey, spicy tones for which Barolo Riservas are famed. This great wine has firm tannins combined with ripe fruit flavours and a long finish.

66. CHÂTEAU BÉARD LA CHAPELLE 2012

St Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux, France [90% Merlot; 7% Cabernet Franc; 3% Cabernet Sauvignon] With a mix of blackcurrant and vanilla aromas lifted by a fresh note of aniseed, this opulent wine is well-balanced with layers of rich black fruit flavours and a long mineral finish that is silky smooth. Situated in the village of St Laurent-des-Combes, the Chateau has been in the same family for nine generations. Since 2006, winemaker Franck, together with his sister Laurence, has worked hard to make the Chateau a success and today Beard La Chapelle is definitely a rising Grand Cru star within the St Emilion Appellation - one to watch in the coming years!

67. CARMENÈRE RESERVA 'In Situ' 2015

Viña San Esteban, Aconcagua Valley, Chile

Ripe, rounded and packed with concentrated plum fruit with hints of liquorice, dark chocolate and spice. Soft, elegant tannins and a long finish. Delicious.

68. CHÂTEAU SOCIANDO-MALLET 2010

Haut-Médoc, Bordeaux, France

The classic 2010 displays everything one expects from this over-achieving Haut-Médoc. A dense purple colour is followed by aromas of blueberries, black currants, graphite and crushed rocks, a layered, full-bodied mouthfeel, stunning concentration and sweet, polished and refined tannins.

70. **'LYTTON SPRINGS' ZINFANDEL 2013**

Ridge Vineyards, Cupertino, Santa Cruz Mountains, California, USA Paul Draper has been the winemaker at Ridge since 1969 and is one of the main revivalists of the Zinfandel grape in California. This is a big, opulent and decadent wine with a voluptuous texture and a focussed, fleshy, black cherry and spicy fruit finish. A real classic from a great vineyard and winemaker.

71. SAINT-JOSEPH 'EMPREINTE' 2013

Chante-Perdrix, Vignobles Verzier, Chavanay, Rhône, France Clearly defined, rich and succulent Northern Rhone Syrah with classic peppery spice and a wonderful vivacity. Matured in oak for twelve months, it shows bright red fruit with aromas of vanilla and black peppercorns. This dynamic estate is perched high up on the steep hillsides above Chavanay and is run by Philipe Verzier, one of the new generation of 'vignerons' who are making considerable waves on the international market.
